- Please complete the Form 1: Application for Permission to Travel School Students form and return to Western Heights College Office.
- After processing an email will be sent to you with your individual bus information, including your designated stops and times. You will receive this prior to the commencement of the 2024 school year. The cost per term is \$125 and payment is required prior to each term for your student to retain their seat.

<u>NB</u>: The bus company will be provided with your child's details and their name will be on the bus driver's list, this means your child does not require a travel pass.

A public transport pass is available for students in Geelong for 2024.

Please follow these steps to purchase a pass:

# <u>Step One</u>

Obtain a 2024 PTV School Student ID and Student Pass Application Form. This can be downloaded from the PTV website (ptv.vic.gov.au) Please note: this form is available from January 1, 2024.

# <u>Step Two</u>

Complete the form and attach 2 passport quality identification photos in the spaces provided on the form.

### Step Three

Take completed form to Western Heights College office for an authorisation stamp.

### <u>Step Four</u>

Take the stamped application form to a 'staffed' train station to be processed and for you to pay the fee. You will receive a Myki card and a photo ID card. The cost is approximately \$177 half yearly.
